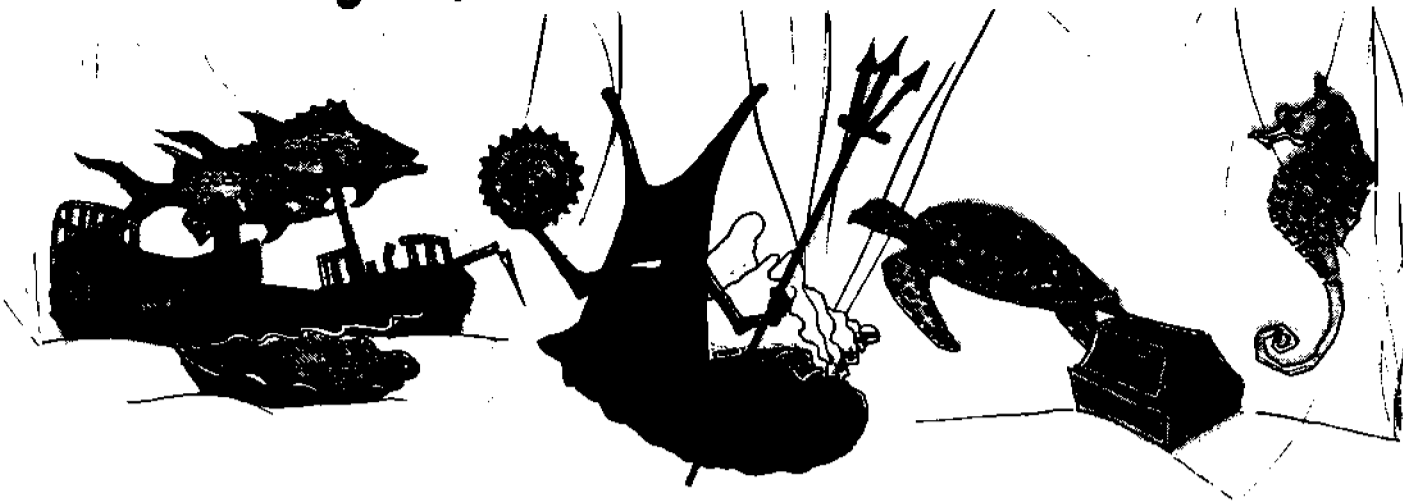

Mayor's Proclamation

LAW DAY PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, this country was founded on the principle that voluntary adherence to the rule of law expands, rather than limits, the opportunities for freedom; and

WHEREAS, a viable democracy requires understanding of the nature and basis of our freedoms and recognition of the Individual responsibilities which those freedoms impose; and

WHEREAS, the Law Day ZOOS, fiftieth anniversary theme of The Rule of Law: Foundation for Communities of Opportunity and Equity encourages us all to examine the rule of law, our role in its sustainability, and its role in protecting our communities, our democracy, opportunity, equity, and all that is most precious to us.

NOW, THEREFORE, by the virtue of the power vested in me as Mayor of Monroe County, I, Sonny McCoy, do hereby proclaim Thursday, May 1, 2008, as
