Project Description

The construction of a new concrete masonry structure of approximately 8,055 square feet located at 220 Reef Drive, Key Largo, Monroe County, Florida. Scope of work includes site work including installation of site utilities and infrastructure, paving, lighting, landscaping, grading, and drainage. Construction of interior partitions and finishes for Fire Station will include gypsum board, metal studs, metal frames, doors, aluminum windows, hardware, carpet, vinyl, and ceramic tile, finishes. Complete plumbing, electrical and HVAC mechanical systems for Fire Station and any equipment unique unto a Fire Station as set forth in the construction documents.

July 1, 2007 Key Largo Fire District held a Dedication Ceremony.

Current Activity Project Completed
