Project Description

The scope of work is for the renovation of the existing concrete structure of approximately 3755 square feet and the addition of a new space comprising an additional 315 square feet. The work will also include: site work, installation of site utilities, lighting, landscaping, grading, and drainage; new interior partitions and finishes, windows, doors, carpet, vinyl, ceramic tile; complete plumbing, electrical and HVAC mechanical systems

Current Activity

As of July 5, 2007: The Tavernier Fire Station work is progressing steadily. All structural components are in place. Plumbing rough-in, electrical rough-in, roof truss installation, and interior partitions installation are complete. Window and door frame installation and the roof installation are scheduled to begin the week of July 9th. Work has started for required fire alarm installations as per code compliance. Excavation of waste treatment system has started.
