

eAudiobooks now available at Monroe County Public Library

Collection provides anytime/anywhere access to over 2,500 titles

If you already have a NetLibrary account, go to the [NetLibrary Log-in page](#) to login, then click on the eAudiobooks link on the right-hand box to start browsing the collection and downloading. We recommend downloading their Media Center software—but it's optional.

It's more likely that you don't have an account already, so you will first need to visit one of our library locations to register/enroll with NetLibrary from a library PC. eAudiobooks are now available at Monroe County Public Library, offering anytime, anywhere access to 2,500 adult and children's eAudiobook titles.

eAudiobooks are books that have been narrated and recorded, featuring notable authors, such as Tim Dorsey and Meg Cabot. Adult and juvenile fiction and non-fiction titles are available. eAudiobooks can be accessed and downloaded via the library's Web site, www.keyslibraries.org. First-time users may need to stop by a Monroe County library and create an online account, then use their own login and password to access the eAudiobooks from anywhere.

“Audiobooks, on cassettes and CDs, have been popular in libraries for many years, while eAudio is being embraced by both long-time listeners as well as new listeners who want material for their portable media devices.” said Norma Kula, Director of Monroe County Public Libraries. “Also, eAudiobooks expand the Library's 24/7 online services to those who have difficulty visiting our locations in person.”

A popular format in many libraries, eAudiobooks allow library users to listen to materials on-the-go. eAudiobooks can be checked out from the library or from a personal computer via the library's Web site. They are automatically returned to the library at the end of the checkout period. eAudiobooks can be downloaded or played on many desktops, laptops or portable devices.
